

Announcement:

McLane Black Lake Fire Department in Olympia, WA is seeking applications for Volunteer Firefighter/EMT position or EMS only position.

McLane Black Lake Fire Department is a all hazard response department that serves a community of over 20,000 residents in 90 square miles. Personnel perform a full range of services all levels of fire suppression, special rescue operations, fire prevention, and emergency medical services, including basic life support ambulance transport. The ideal candidates should be passionate about providing excellent service to the community and customers. The Department's Operations staff currently consists of twenty-eight (28) full-time line personnel (4-Captains, 5-LTs, 19-FF/EMTs) working 24-hour shifts on a 4-platoon work schedule and 18 volunteer firefighting personnel. Volunteers are required to complete 36 hours of shifts and training a month.

Compensation:

Qualifications:

- At least 18 years of age at the time of initial training.
- High School Diploma or GED at the time of initial training.
- Valid Driver's License (WA license required by first day of employment)
- CPAT physical ability test within the six months preceding December 21.

Application Process:

To apply for the position, **all candidates** must submit:

- 1) Application completed and signed
- 2) Any supporting documents
- 3) Succesfully pass written exam with 80%

Items to note:

- Once your application and successful written test is received you will be contacted for further steps via email
- There will be a 6 week Peer Fitness program to help prepare you for the CPAT test Nov11 - Dec 16. Applications submitted before Nov. 2 will be eligible for this program.
- CPAT test will be offered for applicants on Dec 21st and 22nd.
- Interviews will be held the week of Jan. 6
