

THURSTON COUNTY FIRE DISTRICT NO. 9

April 9, 2020

CALL TO ORDER

Commissioner Dale Putnam of District 9 Board of Fire Commissioners called the meeting to order at 1800 hours. Commissioners Mark Thompson, Mark Campeau, and Jesi Chapin; Chief Steve North, EA Davie Kindell, Lt Chris Patti, and Board Secretary Ferol Max attended the regular meeting held via the virtual Zoom platform. Commissioner Rich Milligan was absent.

AGENDA

The agenda was approved as submitted.

ACTION ITEMS

Approval of Minutes: A motion was made and seconded to approve the minutes of March 12, 2020, as well as the minutes of the special meeting on March 19, 2020. The motion carried.

Approval of Vouchers and Payroll: A motion was made and seconded to approve vouchers from Fund 6690 totaling \$428,114.99; the motion carried.

OLD BUSINESS

COVID-19: Lt Patti has been moved to day shift and has been part of the planning with the High Probability Unit (HPU). He reported a full-scale exercise held yesterday went very well.

Crews have been observing strict decontamination protocol and having health screens daily for each shift. There have been eleven patients transported with COVID-19 symptoms, but overall the call volume has been lower than normal.

STAFF REPORTS

Finance: EA Kindell reported property tax revenue is delayed. There is currently about \$330,000.00 in the account and about 25% of the tax revenue is expected on time. MBLFD has a substantial reserve with about \$940,000 in the M&O account, and the apparatus and reserve fund totaling about \$2,000,000. There is a freeze on all but essential spending in the district; projects are on hold and the volunteer force training has been suspended.

Processes are in place for working off site but there have been issues; it was discovered the new server hadn't been fully installed with required updates. Pacific Office will make the transition to the new server tonight. The company has been very supportive and a pleasure to work with.

Chief North extended kudos to EA Kindell for organizing the administrative department needs and to Lt Patti for his work with the operational side.

COMMISSIONER REPORTS

Commissioner Putnam reported TCFCA will meet via conference call to complete immediate business only.

GOOD OF THE ORDER

Chief North has been spending much of his time with emergency management organizations in Western Washington.

The Fire Defense Committee is making preparations for fire season.

ADJOURNMENT

There being no further business, the regular meeting of the Board of Fire Commissioners adjourned at 1825.
