Chapter: Operations

Effective Date: 7/1/98

1.0 POLICY

1.1 Goggles suitable for eye protection shall be provided for and used by members engaged in wildland fire suppression.

- 1.2 Persons whose vision requires the use of corrective lenses in spectacles, and who are required to wear eye protection, shall wear eye protection of the following types:
 - (a) Spectacles with protective lenses that provide optical correction.
 - (b) Spectacles.
 - (c) Goggles that incorporate corrective lenses mounted behind the protective lens.
- 1.3 When limitations or precautions are indicated by the manufacturer, they shall be transmitted to the user and care taken to see such limitations and precautions are strictly observed.
 - (a) Care, use, and maintenance for any type of eye shall follow the manufacturers suggested recommendations.
- 1.4 Goggles shall be inspected, cleaned and disinfected prior to being re-issued to members.

2.0 RESPONSIBILITIES

- 2.1 The Assistant Chief of Operations shall be responsible for the purchase all eye and face protection
- The Assistant Chief of Operations shall be responsible for ensuring the routine inspection repair and replacement of all eye protection.
- 2.3 Members shall be responsible for the routine maintenance of eye/face protection.
